Sec. 51: Promisor not bound to perform unless reciprocal promise is ready & willing to perform.  
Sec. 52: Order of performance of reciprocal promise.  
Sec. 53: liability of a party preventing event on which contract is to take effect.  
Sec. 54: Effect of default as to the promise which should be first perform in contract consisting of reciprocal promise.

- Sec. 55: Effect of failure to perform at fixed time, in which time is essential.  
Sec. 56: Agreement to do impossible act., void  
Sec. 57: Reciprocal promises to do things legal & also other things illegal.  
Sec. 58: Alternative promises, one branch being illegal.  
Sec. 59: Application of payment where debt to be discharge is indicated.

Sec. 61: Application of payment where neither party appropriates.  
Sec. 62: Effect of Novation, Alteration & Recession of contract  
Sec. 63: Promisee may dispense with or remit performance of promise.  
Sec. 64: Consequence of rescission of voidable contract.  
Sec. 65: Obligation of a person who has received advantage under void agreement or void contract  
Sec. 66: Mode of communicating or revoking rescission of voidable contract  
Sec. 67: Effect of neglect of promisee to afford promisor reasonable facility for performance
