<p>Condition vs warranty</p> <p>Condition → Representation (Section) [1+1]</p> <p>time → Delivery (essence → important)</p> <p>Paid → Payment</p> <p>(2.1) → Contract of Sale → Condition → warranty</p> <p>Condition → Main → breach → Contract Canceled</p> <p>(2.2) → Condition → Additional → breach → Only damages</p> <p>(2.3) → In a contract condition stipulation & condition or warranty depends on the circumstances</p> <p>Condition vs warranty</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Main stipulation • Repudiate the contract • Condition can be converted to warranty <p>→ W - waives by buyer (leg - voluntary) I - impossible leg (leg - alternative) S - Non removable in nature E - Started by leg (C → E)</p> <p>Condition → implied conditions</p> <p>① Condition as to time ④ Seller should sell commodity to which it is not the owners or (ii) he does not have right to sell</p> <p>② Sale by description ⑤ If goods has been made in time with description of goods → final product - comply with description</p> <p>③ Sale by sample ⑥ buyer should comply with sample</p> <p>④ Sample as well as ⑦ The goods shall comply with both (1 + 2)</p> <p>⑤ Condition as to quality & fitness ⑧ Seller on the risk and independence of the seller P - Buyer shall define his purpose D - Seller is in position to inspect quality of some goods</p> <p>⑥ Condition as to merchantability ⑨ Normal course of business Setting goods < self use</p> <p>⑦ Condition as to wholeness - to establish exclusively</p>	<p>Warranty Implied</p> <p>① Warranty as to Undelivered possession (1+1) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> → That the buyer shall have the right to enjoy quiet possession of his goods if his use is disturbed he can sue the seller </p> <p>② Warranty as to non-existence of encumbrances (1+1) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> → When goods are transferred to another person they should not have a charge in favour of the buyer party. </p> <p>③ Warranty as to quality or fitness for intended purpose of goods - Some warranties which arise due to regular trading between buyer and seller (general)</p> <p>Seller Starts</p> <p>④ Disclosure as to Dangerous Nature of goods - It seller is aware about the dangerous nature of his goods and knows that the buyer is ignorant he shall disclose the same.
