

IMPORTANT NOTES TO BE GIVEN AT END OF SOLUTION

- In The Absence of Information It is Assumed that Books of Accounts are Being Closed on 31st Dec/31st March & Accordingly BRS is Being Prepared With Adjusted Cash Book.
- Amount Not Received on Transferred to calls in Arrears.
- In The Absence of Relevant Information, Errors are Being Rectified After Preparation of Trial Balance/Before Preparation of Trial Balance.
- In The Absence of Relevant Information , Goods Are Treated as Purchase on Receipt of Goods & Not on Receipt Of Invoice

IMPORTANT POINTS TO BE KEPT IN MIND FOR ACCOUNTS

- Give Narration Whenever Journal Entries Have Been Asked.
- Make total of Journal
- Whenever any figure has been arrived as Balancing Figure indicate it in Bracket
- Avoid Using Short Forms
- Give Proper Heading as Required
- First Give Main Answer & Then Working Notes




DONT's

- Don't use Bullets , Star Marks , Hash Etc for points instead Give Numbering
- Don't Focus Much on Formatting of Working Notes , Dont Waste Much time on it
- Avoid using SMS Type Language

- Don't Discuss Anything About Accounts Paper After 5 PM.






